

[Crossing Boundary Ropes is Prohibited]

Publishing: Niseko Annupuri Avalanche Prevention Committee

- 1) Always use gates when entering backcountry areas.
- 2 Do not duck boundary ropes.
- 3 Everyone skiing/snowboarding in backcountry areas should wear a helmet and carry an avalanche beacon.
- Backcountry skiing/snowboarding is prohibited when gates are closed.
- 5 Never enter off-limits areas at any time (except for official rescue and research operations).
- 6 Elementary school children are not allowed in backcountry areas unless accompanied by an elder
